


Come Learn About Black Hills Ghost Towns Starting this August



Back by popular demand, Bill Swanson & Marty Krause will be conducting a Ghost Towns Class at High Plains Western Heritage Center during a Saturday morning sixweek course beginning in late August. The course will also include hands-on field trips to some of the very ghost towns covered in the class.

Bill and Marty will teach students what a ghost town is, where they are and what to look for when you're out exploring the Black Hills.

Bill has been teaching Ghost Towns of the Black Hills since 1998, when he took over for his father, who ran the class since 1976. He has taught it at the HPWHC before. He is a graduate of Sturgis Brown High School and the United States Merchant Marine Academy. He spent 20 years sailing as an officer on oil tankers and as an officer in the USNR. He has a teaching degree from BHSU in science and is certified in history.





Dave Stamey has been a cowboy, a mule packer, a dude wrangler, and is now one of the most popular Western entertainers working today.

In the midst of his fast-paced touring and performing schedule, Dave wrote and produced his 12th CD called Good Dog. His compositions on this new release are what you come to expect from Dave - witty, heart wrenching, tender and sophisticated. His very latest projects include 2 books. The First Twenty-Five Years, Songs and Stories was released in August 2018. With over 60 Dave Stamey originals and their backstories, one really begins to understand the depth of this songwriter and his creative process. In September 2021, Piga-
